South West TAFE through the Health and Community Service department delivers training and assessment in the following programs: Certificate II, III and Diploma of Community Services, Certificate III in Individual Support, Certificate IV in Disability, Course in Introduction to the NDIS and the Diploma of Nursing. These programs prepare people to work professionally and effectively, to provide person-centred care and support to those in need in our community.

Actors provide acting services on behalf of the Health and Community Services department.

Actors are responsible for the delivery of simulated client role plays to assist students to encounter and respond to a range of simulated case studies. These simulated assessments assist students to be prepared to work in community services with clients when fully qualified. The work requires following case study outlines provided to actors to simulate a real client for students during practical assessment tasks. The role requires people who can read and interpret case studies and authentically represent a client during assessment sessions.

The assessment case studies simulate people who have experienced a range of difficult, distressing or traumatic experiences, for example, family violence. Other case studies may involve mental health and addiction issues. In order to successfully demonstrate these roles actors must have a demonstrated ability to show understanding and empathy.

Actors are expected to work effectively as members of a team and conduct themselves in a professional manner at all times, operating safely, ethically and confidentially.
