Course Overview

Introduction

The Certificate III in Surface Preparation and Coating Application is a trade qualification for work in heavy industry, shipping and infrastructure. This nationally recognised training course will teach you how to prepare surfaces and apply coatings in a range of complex work environments.

The course covers: surface preparations, coating applications, quality systems, computing technologies and much more. Depending on your elective choices you can also obtain a range of WHS permits required by various state government departments.

All of this training is based in the workplace and based on each businesses needs, meaning no disruption to the workplace.

What will I Learn?

SWTAFE will deliver in South Australia a workplace-based learning program incorporating individual workplace facilities to increase your skills and knowledge and practice across the surface preparation and coating application operational areas. The nationally recognised Certificate III in Surface Preparation and Coating Application teaches you techniques to abrasively blast-clean the metal surfaces of heavy industrial machinery, ships and infrastructure. You will pair that knowledge with highly specific protective finishing methods.

- Abrasive blaster

Course Requirements

Entrance requirements & pre-requisites

Must be employed as a trainee at a workplace with access to the facilities and equipment to deliver the course. A minimum number of trainees at the site apply.

Where units require demonstration of skills in a workplace environment, you will have the opportunity to do this either in your own workplace (where appropriate), through a practical placement, or by using one of the Institute's simulated workshops/classrooms. Detailed information about the types, conduct and dates of assessments will be provided in advance. You will also be provided with information about the opportunity for reassessment and appeal.

Fees

Course Fees

Here's an outline of fees and costs associated with your course.

Resource and/or materials costs

Some courses require specific resources or materials necessary for your study eg: tools of the trade, excursions, etc. Final costs will be determined upon enrolment.

How do I pay my fees?

Once we have processed your enrolment form, you will receive an email with your invoice.

You have three options when organising your payment:

- 1. Upfront payment can be made over the phone with EFTPOS
- Payment plan can be directly debited from your bank account, debited from your Centrelink payments or via a <u>VET Student Loan</u> (for diploma or advanced diploma courses only)
- 3. Paid by employer, school or job network agency if your fees are being paid by your employer, school or job network agency, you will need to complete an Authority to Invoice form.

Payments will need to be arranged within five(5) business days of receiving the email containing your invoice.

We also offer a range of scholarships each year which you may be eligible to apply for to assist with course fees.
