Explore hand-cut stencils and hand-painted screen-filler methods to produce prints
- **Printing Skills**
Develop practical experience mixing inks, setting up screens, registering layers, and printing consistent duplicates

For this course, you will need to:

What to bring:

- A4 Sketchbook - for colour and design activities
- General kit - pencils, scissors, ruler, eraser, and a compass
- shirt or apron – to protect clothing from inks
- Wear sturdy shoes

The following items are required after week 2:

- Print surfaces – e.g., t-shirts, tote bags, t-towels, fabric, paper, card, or other items
- Extra pieces of fabric to experiment with different colours and layers suitable for screen printing
- One screen frame will be supplied; the participant must provide any additional frames
