## Introduction

This course will give you the skills and knowledge in the operation of up to 4 types of machinery - skid loaders, articulated front end loaders, rollers and you can pick either excavator or backhoe.

Through a combination of classroom learning and practical training our experienced trainers will teach you to operate and work with heavy earthmoving machinery on a simulated worksite.

On successful completion of this course you will receive certificates of competency for the use of rollers, skid steer loaders, wheeled loader operations and one of excavator or backhoe.

The course runs for six weeks. This time can be reduced if you only choose specific machinery to complete and at the assessors discretion for experienced operators. Contact us to find out more.
